Important Information - Arrangements for Sports Day 2023 for Years 4, 5 and 6

Our annual Sports Day is to be held on the school field on **Thursday 29th June**. For those parents new to our school, this is a family day, with parents being invited to come along and bring a picnic lunch to have with their child which can be eaten on the school field, from 12noon until 12.50pm (weather permitting!).

Children will come into school at their normal time on the day, wearing PE kit and a top/t-shirt featuring their house colours:

Unicorn - BLUE
Griffin - YELLOW
Phoenix - RED
Dragon - GREEN

Children from **Years 4, 5 and 6** will come out onto the field with their class teachers at **1.15pm** for a carousel of activities, followed by races - either taking part in main races or watching the main races staying with their teacher at all times. Parents are welcome to join us and support the children for this.

The Friends Group will be providing refreshments throughout the day, including a raffle which will be drawn before home time.

A 45 minute Laser tag session will also be timetabled in for each class, in the morning from 9.45am to midday. More information to follow.

At lunchtime (12pm) children will be collected from the main yard and may join their parents for lunch on the field but **MUST** be back - again on the main yard - for 12.50pm to get the register taken, ready for the afternoon activities/races. Children will be dismissed at their usual time and place at the end of the school day.

Children who would normally stay for a school meal, but would like to join their parents for the picnic, must inform the school by **MONDAY 19TH JUNE** so that we have time to cancel their lunches. Changes after this date may have to be paid for. If you cannot attend Sports Day for whatever reason but would like your child to have a picnic with another family member or friend, your permission must be given in writing prior to Sports Day. Any child who does not have written permission will be supervised by members of staff and will not be able to go out onto the field. A special lunch will be provided by the kitchen for those children who are not having a picnic and require a school meal.
