

We have been learning these words - say the sounds / blend together to read the word.

Cut them up:

- Use letter cards to locate letters on request.
- Say the sounds in words for your child to blend orally. (Use picture cards to support.)
Be careful not to add sounds eg. say 'mmmmm' not 'muh' (c, t, h, are similar)
- Flash cards to practise until they know them instantly
- Make a matching set - play lotto or pairs snap
- Take turns - you ask for a word for your child to find / then let them be the teacher.
- Make some obvious mistakes so that they can correct.
- 5 minutes every day will make a huge difference in your child's learning.
- When the children can read them - practise spelling them (copy first / spell out and write / write and spell from memory).



