Important Information - Arrangements for Foundation Stage Sports Day 2024

Our annual Foundation Stage Sports Day is to be held in the small yard **Thursday 27th.**

The Reception Class ONLY - races will be during the morning session from 9.10am on the school field (approx. 50mins). The children will need to wear their house team colours (T-shirt) and shorts/ trainers.

Unicorn - BLUE
Griffin - YELLOW
Phoenix - RED
Dragon - GREEN

Bring something along to sit on to show your support. Afterwards, we will then be joined by the nursery children to begin our 'fun interactive session', leading up to the family picnic, from midday.

All nursery children and families are invited to join us in an active morning –participating in a range of fun outdoor skills, activities and races (if they wish), in a more relaxing arena, for them, **from 10.15am**. Come along and 'play' alongside the staff and children. You will then be able to attend the family picnic with your child. Nursery children should wear their school PE kit for the day.

Parents do not need to attend for the full session, but we welcome your support.

At lunchtime (12pm) children will be collected from the small yard and may join their parents for lunch on the small yard or the main field but **MUST** be back - again on the small yard - **from 12.50pm** to get the register taken for Reception children and those nursery children in for Thursday afternoon.

During the afternoon session you may take your child with you to see the older children racing (Yrs 4 to 6) but may not take your child away from school. All children leaving with parents must be signed out with Mrs Wilson/Miss Flanagan, on the day.

Please note that any pupil not having a picnic lunch on field with parents/family/carers will be supervised by staff and will receive a special lunch.

As previously stated, if you wish someone else to collect your child then written permission must be given.

Children will be dismissed at their usual time and place in school, at the end of the school day. If you are collecting a sibling from another class at an earlier time and want to collect your child from EYFS, please come to the side gate leading onto the small yard and speak to a member of staff,

There are limited toilet facilities on site, which adults can access from the main entrance. School age children can access their own toilets unaccompanied via the gate onto the main yard. Our First Aiders on site are Mrs Baker and Mrs Smith, again, any first aid needs should go to the main school office.

Finally, can I request that you don't share photographs of other children, during Sports Day, on social media - for various safeguarding reasons.
