<u>Updates</u>

The aim of the meeting was to look at current behaviour in school and fundraising for two buddy benches in school.

We discussed how to raise funds to install two benches in school. Ideas included:

- Making and selling "kindness rocks".
- A fundraising walk from school to Friendship Island in Chile (virtual) via the Daily Mile.
- Stalls at the Easter, Christmas Fayre.
- Contacting firms to sponsor the buddy bench.
- Making friendship pillows.
- Holding a "Kindness Day".
